County Profile Information

Atchison County, Kansas

According to figures provided in the Kansas Statistical Abstract, the population of Atchison county was approximately 16513 in 2014. This represents a -2.43% change or net migration since the 2010 United States Census. With a total number of 431.2 square miles in the county, the population density for the county is 39.1 people per square mile. Approximately 1.4 of the square miles within the county is considered to be urban while 65.85 percent of the population lives in urban areas. This places the county in the KDHE population peer group of a Densely-Settled Rural area. According to projections reported in the Kansas Statistical Abstract, the percentage change in total population through the year 2040 is estimated at -2.12 for the county.

County Health Rankings:

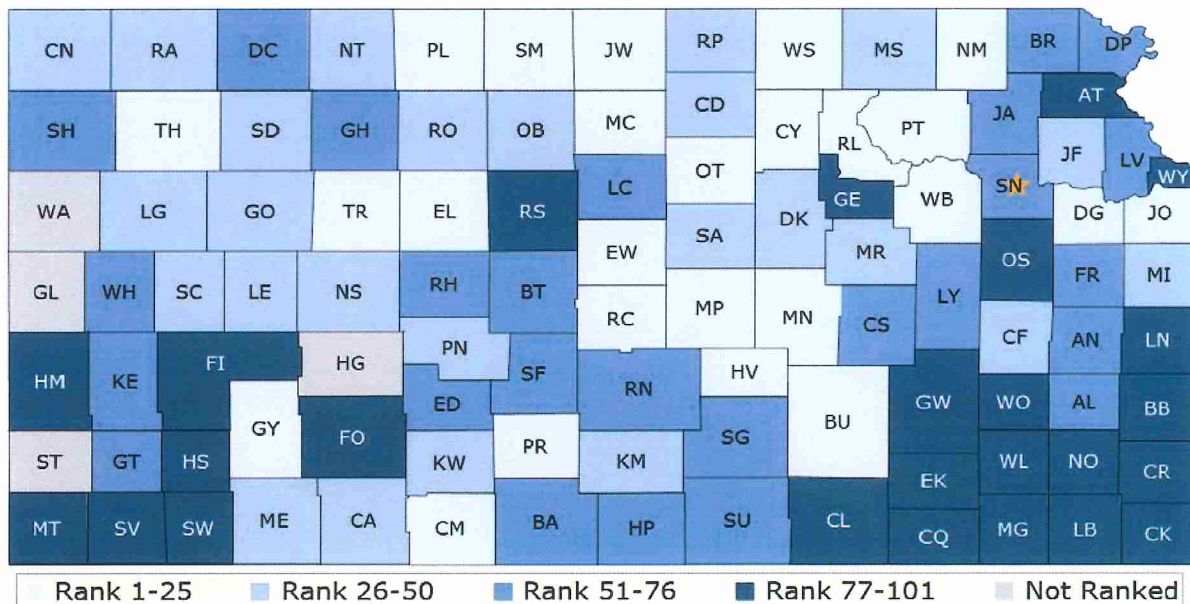
The County Health Rankings (provided by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation) measure the health of nearly all counties in the nation and rank them within states. The Rankings are compiled using county-level measures from a variety of national and state data sources with 1 being the best.

The overall rankings in health factors represent what influences the health of a county. They are an estimate of the future health of counties as compared to other counties within a state. The ranks are based on four types of measures: health behaviors, clinical care, social and economic, and physical environment factors.

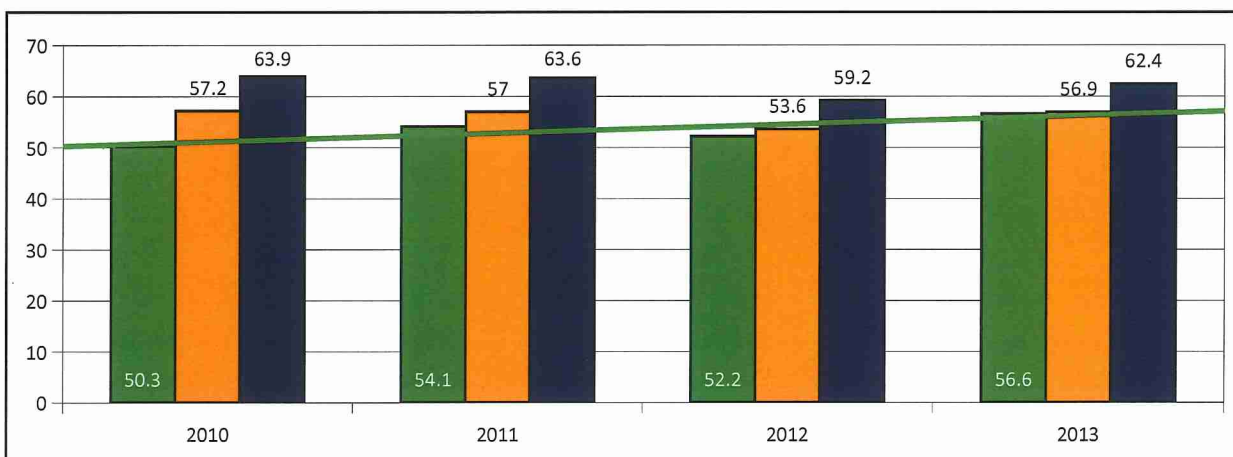

EMPLOYMENT STATUS - % Population over 16 who are in the civilian labor force and employed

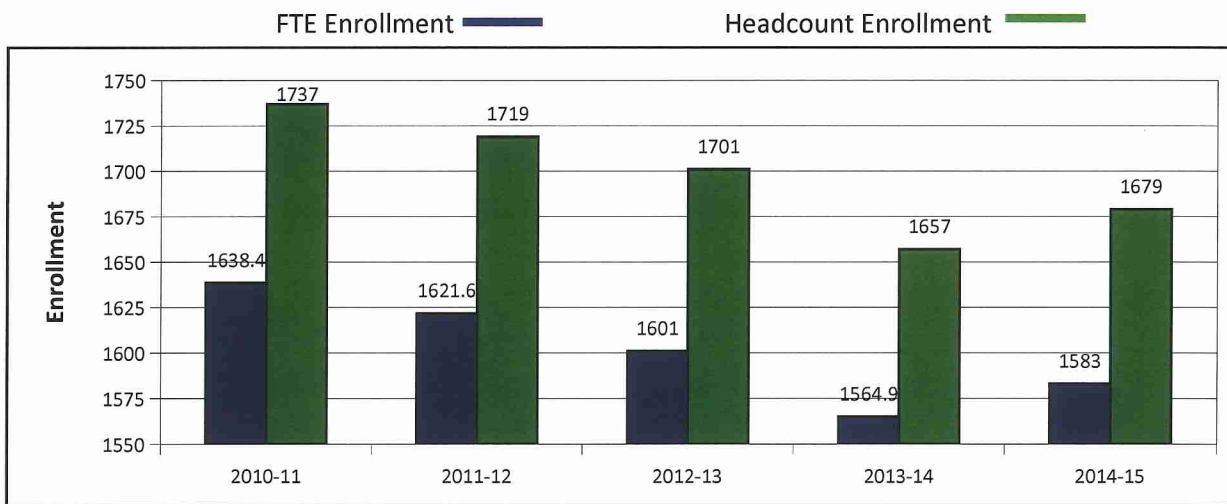

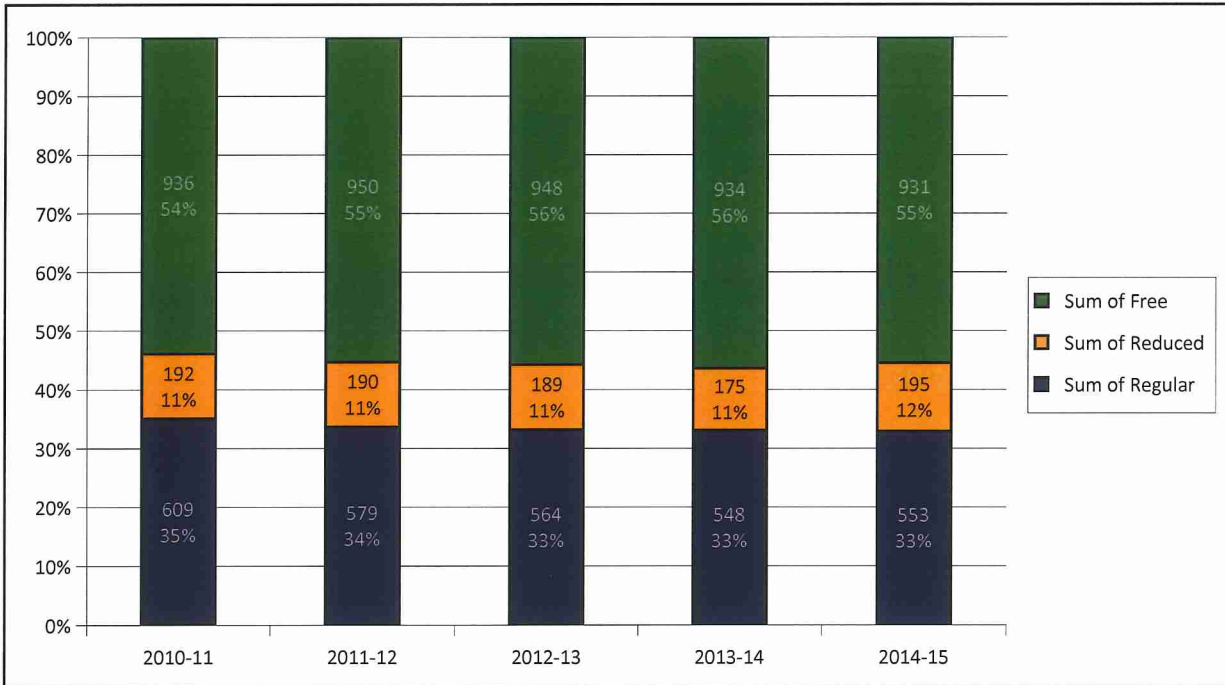

DISTRICT HISTORY FREE REDUCED LUNCH ELIGIBILITY:

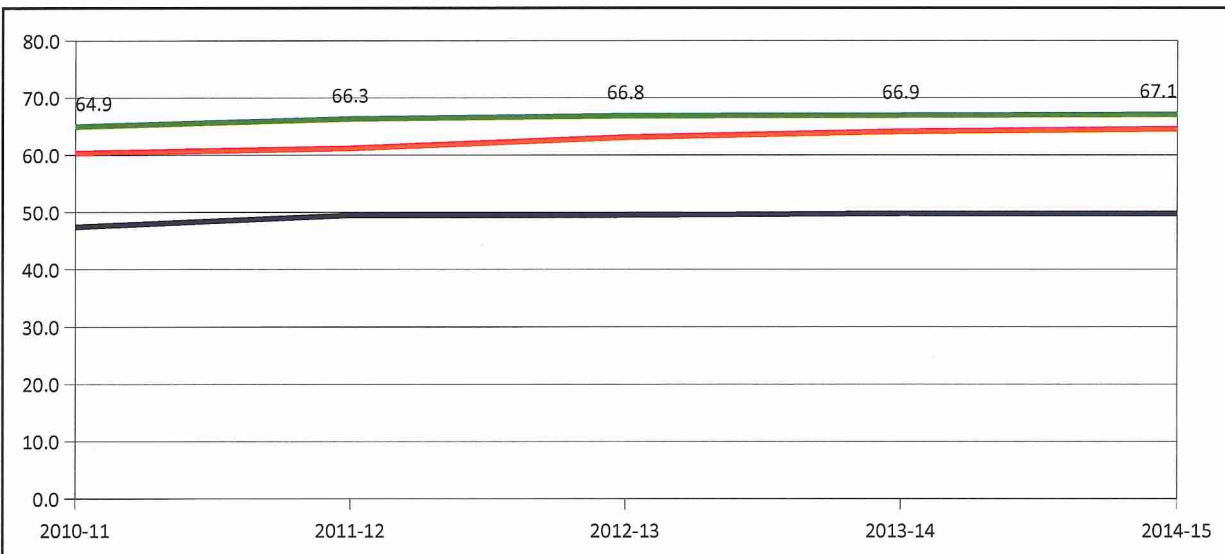
This graphic shows the changes in the percentage of students eligible for free lunch, reduced lunch, or no eligibility for the past several years.

The following chart shows the eligibility for free and reduced lunches over time as compared to the county and state averages for the same school years.

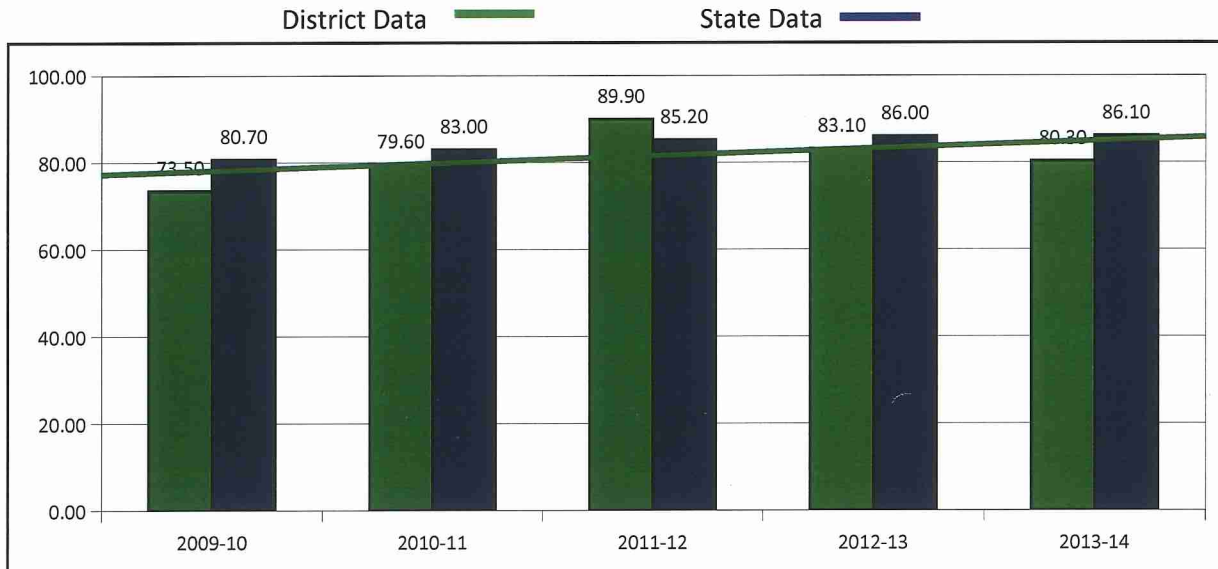

4-YEAR COHORT GRADUATION RATES (ALL STUDENTS):



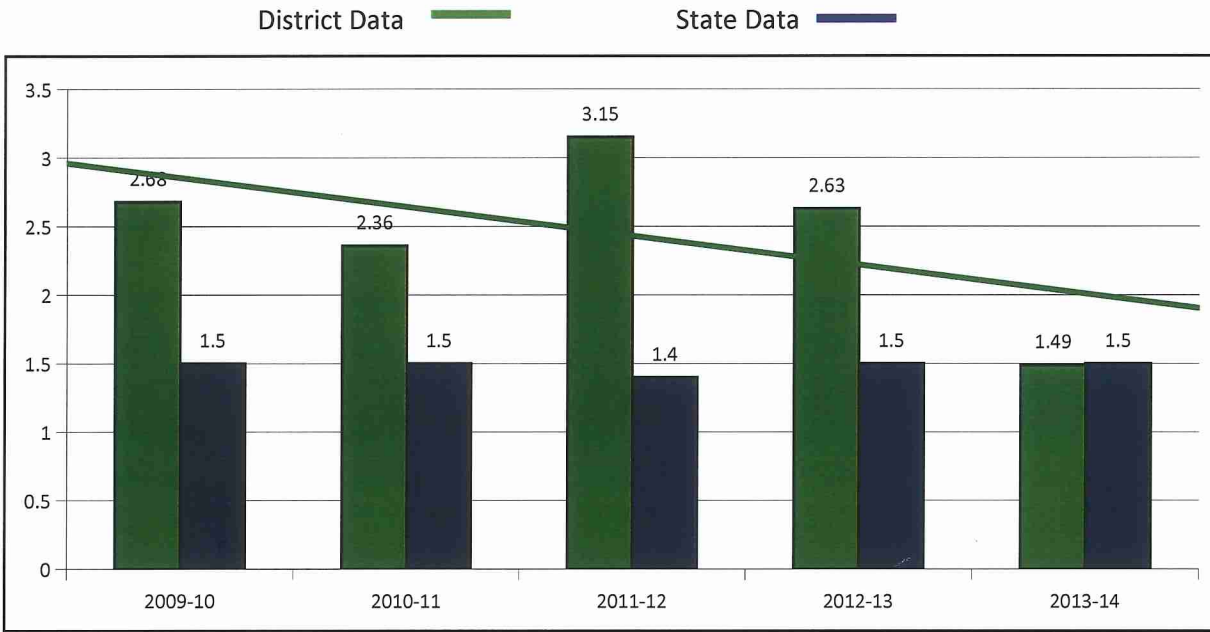

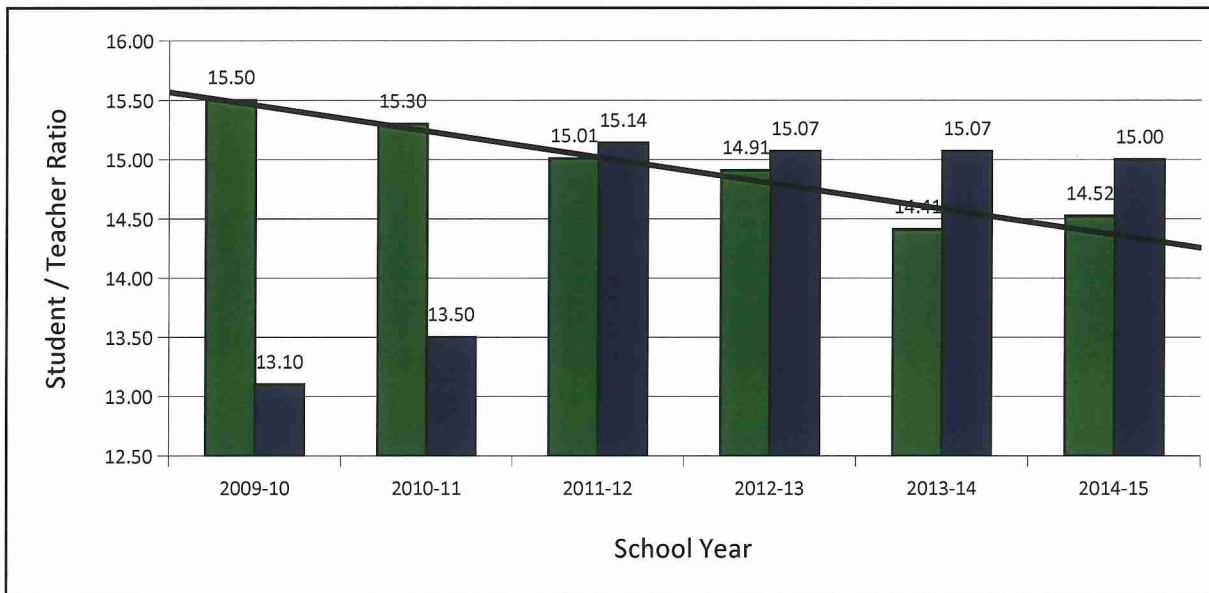

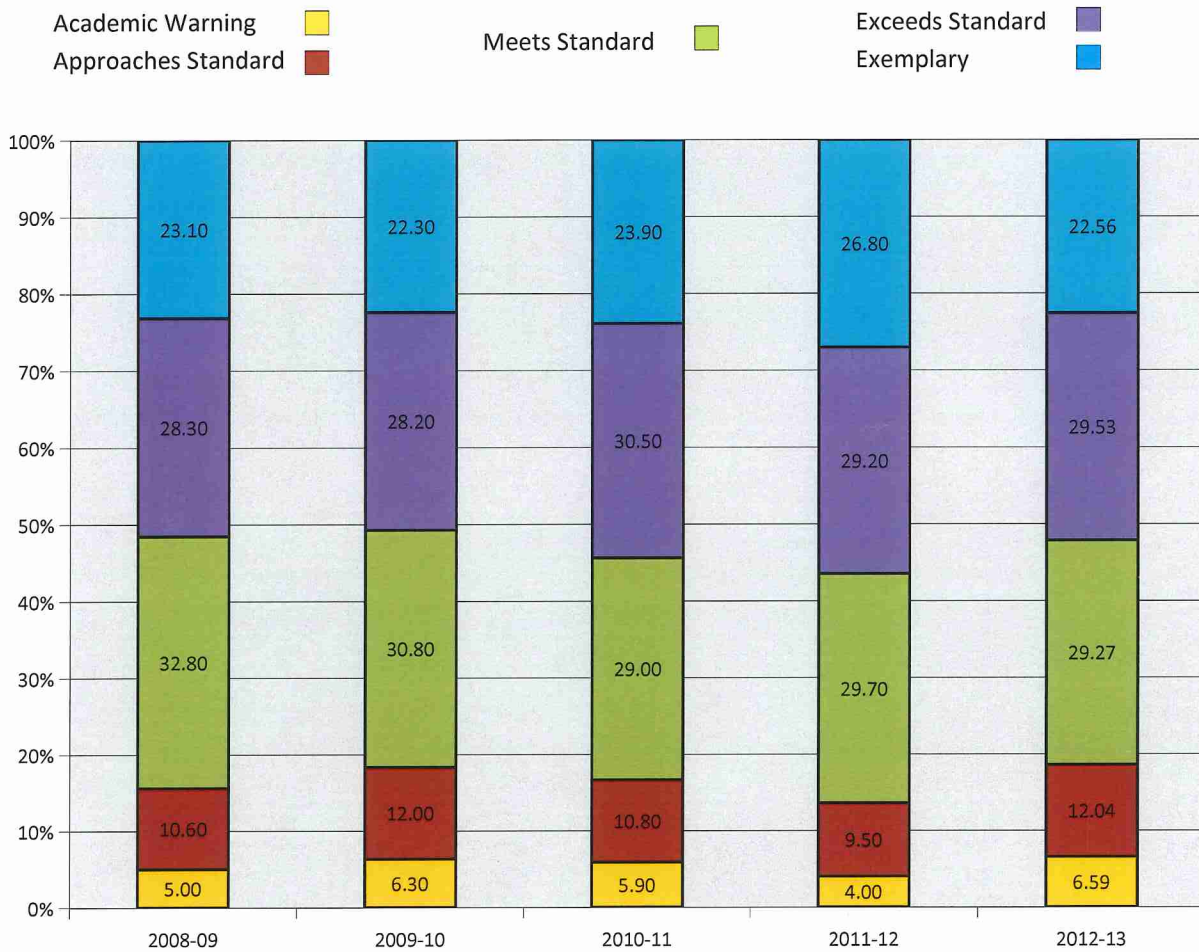
STUDENT / TEACHER RATIO:

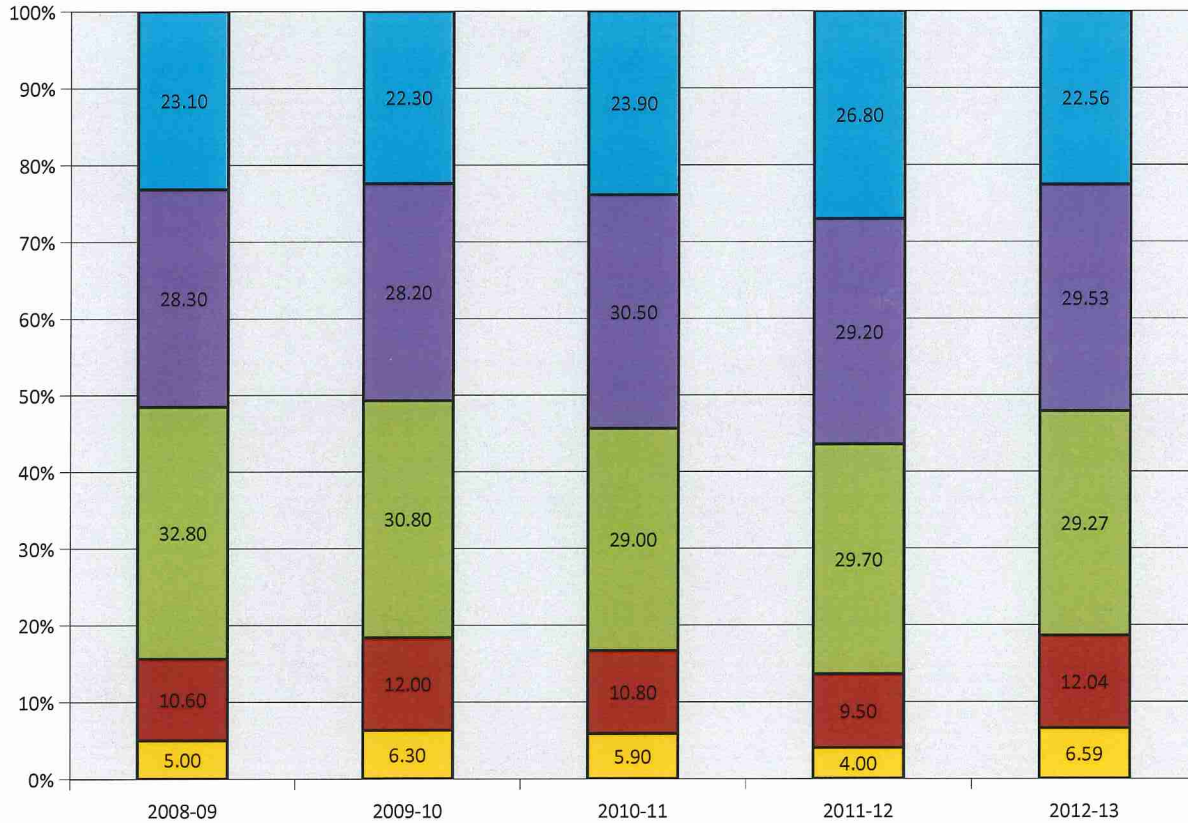
