The Joel Wilburn SCHOLARSHIP will be awarded to a student in the Atchison High School graduating class of 2020. This scholarship will be paid to the school of the recipient's choice and will be paid upon the scholarship committee receiving proof of enrollment.

The scholarship recipient MUST major in PUBLIC SERVICE or a related field.

The applicant MUST be a graduating high school senior.

The scholarship recipient MUST enroll as a FULL-TIME student at the undergraduate level, taking at least 12 hours of college credit upon enrollment. (Family Members of the selection committee ARE eligible to apply/receive the scholarship). SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION COMMITTEE CONFLICT OF INTERST FORM WILL APPLY.

Applicants must be an Atchison County Resident and a graduating student of ATCHISON HIGH SCHOOL in 2020.

The Scholarship MUST be used at an ACCREDITED two-year or four-year college or university.

Applications MUST be on the approved application form.

Applications MUST be submitted with three letters of recommendations;

Applications MUST be submitted with an essay: Why do you feel you're the best candidate for the SCHOLARSHIP;

Applications must contain a recent photo of the applicant;

Application MUST BE POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN MARCH 31, 2020.

The Scholarship Committee will conduct oral interviews for approximately 15 minutes per finalist(s) at the Atchison High School or residence of a committee member.
